## **NOTICE OF CLAIM AND REQUEST FOR STATUS CONFERENCE AND APPOINTMENT OF SUCCESSOR EXECUTOR**

NOW INTO COURT, through undersigned claimant, comes Barney Donalson dba God's Property Ministries, who respectfully files this Notice of Claim and Request for Status Conference, and states as follows:

### **1. Pending and Incomplete Succession:**

The succession of Louis Thibodeaux has been pending before this Honorable Court since January 24, 2020, when the Court entered an Order to Probate and Execute Notarial Testament. However, no further filings appear in the record to show that the estate has been fully administered, inventoried, or closed.

### **2. Lack of Administration:**

Upon information and belief, no sworn descriptive list of assets has been filed, no notice to creditors has been published, and no order of possession or authority to transfer estate property has been issued by this Court.

### **3. Improper Use of Court Order in Texas:**

It has come to the claimant's attention that Lisa Girot, who filed the initial petition in this succession, caused a copy of this Court's 2020 Order to Probate and Execute Notarial Testament to be recorded in the real property records of Harris and Van Zandt County, Texas, representing it as a final probate or completed succession proceeding.

Thereafter, Ms. Girot conveyed real property located in Harris and Van Zandt County, Texas, without first obtaining authority from this Court.

**4. Possible Fraud or Misrepresentation:**

Such use of a preliminary Louisiana order in another jurisdiction, to convey real property while this succession remains open and unadministered, constitutes a misrepresentation of this Court's authority and a potential fraud upon third parties and this succession estate.

**5. Request for Judicial Review:**

Because this succession has remained dormant for several years and appears to lack proper administration, the claimant respectfully requests that this Court: **(a)** Set a status conference to review the present condition of the succession proceedings; **(b)** Direct Ms. Girot to appear and account for all actions taken on behalf of the estate; **(c)** Consider the appointment of a successor executor or administrator, other than Ms. Girot, to complete the succession in accordance with Louisiana law.
